We followed up on the [REDACTED] matter, she was an employee of Epstein's in the 1990s when she was in her 20s. The attorney was looking for any and all documentation regarding [REDACTED] 1996 complaint and her 2006 interview. We can't find any documentation regarding a complaint nor could we find a 302 for [REDACTED]. We only found an EC requesting travel authority to go to North Carolina to interview her and Austin to interview her sister, [REDACTED]. There is only a 302 for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is [REDACTED] so they probably came to the conclusion that any victimization was outside the statute of limitations. Her younger sister, [REDACTED], was interviewed in the MM case back in 2006 and she advised in the 90's she went to [REDACTED] and "cuddled" with Epstein, and Maxwell allegedly rubbed her breasts during a massage. Neither [REDACTED] nor [REDACTED] were pursued any further. We told the attorney she would have to seek any relevant documentation through the official FOIPA process, which would be Miami's problem, not ours.
