- Showed JA message book seized from office off kitchen in JE PB residence (Item #2 on Property Receipt). JA only shown the message pad form that set of three with the earliest dates, dating back to 2002.
 - JA recognized as one of the message books that JE's employees would take messages into. JA confirmed that employees would write the messages at or near the time of the phone calls they received, that writing the messages were kept in course of regularly conducted activity as employee of JE, and that maintaining the messages was a regular practice of that activity.
 - JA recognized his own handwriting and his wife's handwriting on various pages of the message book:
 - Page 1, top two and bottom right were JA handwriting
 - Page 2, top left was JA's wife; top right and both bottom were JA
 - Page 3, top left was JA's wife; both bottom were JA; DNR top right
 - Page 4, top half of both top were JA's handwriting, but bottom half of those two messages weren't his handwriting; both bottom were JA
 - Page 5, top left and bottom left were JA's wife, top right and bottom right were JA
 - Page 6, top half of top left was JA's wife, but DNR bottom half of that message; top right and bottom right both JA; DNR bottom left
 - Page 7, top left was JA; top half of top right is JA's handwriting, and JA believes the rest of the handwriting on this message may be GM's; DNR bottom left
 - Page 8, top left was JA; DNR remaining messages on this page
 - Pages 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13: DNR messages on these pages. Dates are after JA left JE's employment, so JA would not have written any of those messages. Did not review any pages after page 13.
- Prepared for trial testimony. JA's previously undisclosed, clarifying, or different recollections below:
 - JA recalls seeing [REDACTED] get onto JE's plane on the same day when she was at JE's house with a suitcase. JA recalls going to the airport that day.
 - JA recalls one time in or around the 1990s when he saw GM crying. JA was driving GM somewhere, and GM was in the back of the car crying. JA asked GM "why do you put up with this stuff?" JA meant, why does GM put up with JE messing with all these other girls because JA didn't understand why GM would put up with it. GM responded "I cannot leave" and stopped crying after that.
 - JA estimates JE's home had 6 bathrooms before an addition was added, then it had 6 bedrooms and about 6 bedrooms.
 - JA recalls JE's house being white, then pink.

- JA believes GM told him not to look JE in the eyes and not to engage in conversation about 8 months before JA left JE's employment.
- JA recalls Sen. Edward Kennedy and General Wesley Clark coming to JE's PB residence.
- JA recalls a girlfriend named Francis who JE dated at the same time as GM, but before [REDACTED], in the 1990s.
- JA estimates he met [REDACTED] around 1996 or 1997, but is still unsure of the exact date. Is certain she [REDACTED].
- JA did not know [REDACTED] last name when he first knew her.
- JA recalls [REDACTED] bringing her boyfriend to JE's BP house once, but GM said the boyfriend had to stay in the car and couldn't come inside.
- GM told JA when to buy supplies for massages for JE
