It would be fine for you to show up at the airport with two bags (first bag is free...the second bag will be \$100 or MORE if you wait to let Lot know of this second bag) You should CALL Lot with the dimension and weight of this extra bag before Thursday (Lot [REDACTED]) and pay the \$100 for the extra bag (or did Jeffrey say he will pay this? If so, just give me the information and I will call for you) Regarding shipping your other 2 bags, you will need to find a place that ships bags internationally...have you done this before? I see some places on line...you will need the weight of your bags...I found a place (Luggagefree.com) and they state it is \$11.10 per a pound to ship a bag internationally...it take 5-7 business days...Their phone number: [REDACTED]...I would get moving on this right away...I found another place that would not be able to ship your bags until July!...it may be easier to just have Lot take all your bags...you should do a price comparison...or maybe you can Fed Ex the boxes?
